

## Yancey Donor Resource Guide Qualifications

To be included on the list, a nonprofit must be a 501c3 nonprofit in good standing with the IRS. This list is vetted on an annual basis and was last reviewed on 7/1/21. Nonprofits were vetted through [the IRS website at this link](#).

This resource was developed by a group of community-minded individuals who, with good faith, set out to compile a list of active nonprofits serving residents in Yancey County, categorize their services, and make them available to you. This list was assembled utilizing local knowledge, existing databases online (i.e. IRS), and public postings through the local newspaper inviting organizations to submit information.

Please note: this list is not all-inclusive of every organization. We recognize there are 501c3 nonprofits in good-standing with the IRS that are not included due to any number of factors (i.e. known inactivity). We welcome input on this resource and especially information regarding organizations to consider for inclusion and/or reclassification.

Furthermore, we acknowledge there are charitable causes within the community (i.e. Shop with a Cop) which are also not included. Local government agencies and places of worship are also not listed in this resource, as our intent was to highlight 501c3 nonprofit organizations and their primary missions. In all these cases, information seekers are encouraged to research both charitable organizations included through this resource and those which are not.

Finally, the classification descriptions provided within the resource are supplied as general statements and may not accurately describe the nonprofit listed within. Please note: Some nonprofit organizations are listed in multiple categories.
